

APPLICATION OF 702/703/704 MP CABINETS IN THIN WALLS

Climate Master MP cabinets can be used on any size wall -- from a 1" panel wall to a 25" deep wall. This Application Note explains how an MP cabinet is used in a wall less than 10" in depth.

The smallest wall box available is a 10" wall box. When used in a thin wall application, this wall box is mounted flush to the outside wall. Part of the wall box will extend into the room, seen as dimension B in Figure 1. If the wall is 4" deep or less, support brackets are required. As with all installations, the wall box must be installed with the top level.

An added depth room cabinet is used in this application. The added depth cabinet contains the wall box mounting flange at the appropriate depth to mount the cabinet to the wall box. The cabinet completely covers the wall box.

Note also that the adjustable height kick plate grows in depth in proportion to the depth of the cabinet.



702 AUXILIARY POWER SUPPLY OPTION FOR EVAPORATOR FAN OPTION

The auxiliary power supply option on a steam or hot water heat 702 Series packaged terminal unit allows the unit to continue to heat the space on a loss of main power in the building. The compressor is not powered from the emergency power supply. The indoor fan and heating valve are powered from the emergency supply in normal operation as well as during power failure, which reduces the power requirements of the emergency power source.






ARCHITECTURAL OUTSIDE LOUVER


For Use With 702 / 703 / 704 MP & SP UNITS

1. Remove temporary weather panel from wall box or sleeve and discard.
2. Tie a safety line to louver to prevent it from falling during installation.
3. With safety line attached, insert louver through wall box or sleeve.
4. Turn louver so that vanes angle downward.
5. Align 4 bolts on louver with 4 holes in wall box or sleeve.
6. Pull louver tight against wall box or sleeve and tighten with 4 nuts provided.
7. Remove safety line.

FLANGED LOUVER COLLAR




The flanged louver collar is designed to hide any imperfections on the exterior wall around a Climate Master 702, 703 or 704 Packaged Terminal Unit.

In retrofit applications in particular, it is not always possible to cut a clean hole in the wall. The flanged louver collar hides any chips or holes around the unit and gives a clean, neat and consistent appearance to the outside of the building.



ADDITIONAL APPLICATIONS FOR 702/703/704
FLANGED LOUVER COLLAR

(1) On inside wall:

With the SP cabinet, the flanged louver collar can be used on the inside wall around the unit, as shown in Figure #1. Contact the factory for details on painted (beige) flanged collars.



(2) As wall box or cabinet sleeve extension:

The collar can be used to extend the depth of the wall box or sleeve up to one inch as shown in Figure #2.


